- 2. Submit 5 pieces of artwork to be returned after the selection process.
- 3. Submit 3 letters of recommendation including one from a visual arts instructor. These can be mailed directly to the address below or sealed in an envelope and sent with the application.
- 4. Attach an up-to-date copy of college transcript. Optional: high school transcript.
